e) During the year under review, there had been two instances when violations of Code of Conduct under SEBI (Prohibition of Insider Trading) Regulations, 2015 and the Code of Internal Procedures and Conduct for regulating, monitoring and reporting of trading by Designated Persons framed by the Company taken place. In one case, it was by an employee and in another case it was by immediate relative of an employee of the Company. The Company had sought explanation/clarification for the aforesaid violations. Both the cases were brought to the notice of the Share Transfer & Shareholders Grievance — cum — Stakeholders Relationship Committee and Board of Directors as well at their respective meetings. The reported violations being the first instances inadvertently done by the Designated Persons, the listed entity had issued them respective strict warning letters and also reported the same to the SEBI and the stock exchanges as well.
