- I, Hemang M. Mehta, Proprietor of H. M. Mehta & Associates, Practicing Company Secretaries, having office at 301, MindTree Building, A/3, Sunmoon Park Co. Op. Society, Near Radha Krishna Crossing, Towards PF Office, Akota, Vadodara-390020, Gujarat, India was appointed as a Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of Apar Industries Limited ("the Company") under the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended from time to time) for the purpose of scrutinizing the process of remote e-voting process and e-voting contained in the notice dated 25th June, 2020 ("Notice") issued in accordance with the General Circular Nos. 14/2020, 17/2020, 20/2020 & 22/2020 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs on 08th April, 2020, 13th April, 2020, 05th May, 2020 and 15th June, 2020, respectively and SEBI Circular dated 12th May, 2020 ("MCA and SEBI Circulars") calling the Thirty-First Annual General Meeting of its Equity Shareholders ("31st AGM") through Video Conferencing (VC) / Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM) facility. The AGM was convened on Monday, 17th August, 2020 at 2:30 P.M. (IST) through VC / OAVM.
- 2. The management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of (i) the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules made thereunder; (ii) MCA and SEBI Circulars and (iii) the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("LODR") relating to voting through electronic means on the resolutions contained in the Notice of the 31st AGM of the members of the Company. My responsibility as a scrutinizer for the remote e-voting and e-voting is restricted to making a Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast "in favour" or "against" the resolutions set forth in the Notice of the aforesaid 31st AGM based on reports generated from the e-voting system provided by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), being the authorized agency engaged in by the Company for the said 31st AGM.
- 3. Further to above, I submit my report as under:
- 3.1 The Company had sent Notice dated 25th June, 2020 convening the 31st AGM along with Statement setting out material facts under Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 and Annual Report 2019-20 by electronic means i.e. on the registered e-mail IDs of the Shareholders on 22nd July, 2020, as the case may be, to those members whose names appeared in the Register of Members / List of Beneficiaries as on 17th July, 2020 (being cut-off-date for sending annual report to the shareholders).

As per the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, the numbers of votes cast in respect of each resolution have been counted according to the numbers of shares held by the concerned shareholders. One share held equal to one vote.

- 3.2 The Company arranged for remote e-voting facility provided by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for conducting remote e-voting by the Shareholders of the Company on AGM Resolutions. The Company has also provided e-voting facility as provided by CDSL to the Shareholders during the AGM to vote on the Resolutions set out in the Notice of the said AGM, if they had not cast their vote earlier through remote e-voting.
- 3.3. The above Notice was also placed on the website of the Company (<u>www.apar.com</u>) forthwith after it was sent to the members.
- 3.4. The notice clearly indicated the process and manner for voting by electronic means and the time schedule of voting from Thursday, 13th August, 2020 (10:00 Hours) to Sunday, 16th August, 2020 (17:00 Hours) during which the votes could be cast and also provided the login ID and created facility for generating password and casting of vote in a secured manner.
- 3.5. As prescribed in the aforesaid Rules and MCA and SEBI Circulars, the Company has also published an advertisement in nationwide daily newspaper in "Business Standard" (English language) and in "Vadodara Samachar" (Gujarati language) on 24th July, 2020 and it carried the required information as specified in the said Rules.
- 3.6. The remote e-voting remained open for a period of 4 days i.e. from Thursday, 13th August, 2020 (10:00 Hours) to Sunday, 16th August, 2020 (17:00 Hours) and that the aforesaid remote e-voting period was completed one day prior to the date of the 31st AGM which held on Monday, 17th August, 2020.
- 3.7. The Equity Shareholders holding shares as on the "cut-off-date" i.e. Monday, 10th August, 2020 were entitled to vote on the proposed resolutions (Item Nos. 01 to 05) as set out in the Notice of the 31st Annual General Meeting of the Apar Industries Limited either through remote evoting or through e-voting during the AGM.
- 3.8. The attendance of Eighty Two (82) Members was registered who attended the AGM through VC/OAVM as per the MCA Circulars.
- 3.9. After completion of e-voting during the AGM, the data of e-voting was diligently scrutinized. Thereafter, data of e-voting were reconciled with the records maintained by the Link Intime India Private Limited, Vadodara, Registrar and Share Transfer Agent of the Company and the Authorizations lodged with the Company. Detailed registers were maintained containing the summary of results of remote e-voting and e-voting during AGM.
- 3.10. Thereafter, the votes cast through remote e-voting as well as e-voting at AGM were unblocked after completion of e-voting during the AGM in the presence of two witnesses, (1) Mr. Parth Nashikkar, resident of A/11, Shree Yamunakunj Society, Behind Gajanan Heights, Darbar Chowkdi, Manjalpur, Vadodara-390011, Gujarat, India and (2) Ms. Kinjal Shah, resident of G-301, Pancham Elite, opposite Mukhi Nagar Char Rasta, Khodiyar Nagar, Vadodara-390018 Gujarat, India, who are not in the employment of the Company. They have signed below mentioned confirmation of the votes being unblocked in their presence.

3.11. Thereafter, the details containing, inter alia, list of equity shareholders, who voted "for", "against" each of the resolutions that were put to vote, were generated from the remote evoting website of CDSL i.e. www.evotingindia.com

The remote e-voting data was scrutinized by the undersigned for verification of the votes cast in favour of or against the resolutions.

4. Based on the Reports generated from the e-voting website of CDSL at the 31st AGM of Apar Industries Limited, I hereby submit my Consolidated Report on the result of the remote e-voting together with that of e-voting during the 31st AGM in respect of the said Resolutions as under:
